

Vaccines to save Qld cattle industry millions

UNIVERSITY of Queensland scientists are pushing ahead to develop two advanced vaccines that could save the Queensland cattle industry more than \$360 million a year.

Costly cattle tick infestations and three bovine diseases - bovine viral diarrhoea virus (BVDV), bovine ephemeral fever (BEF) and cattle tick fever (Anaplasmosis) - are firmly in the crosshairs of researchers.
